REPORT

NAIDOC Week celebrates the history, culture and achievements of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander peoples.

The week is celebrated not just in Indigenous communities but also in increasing numbers of government agencies, schools, local councils and workplaces. Kiama Council had a leading role in hosting the NAIDOC awards last year and participating in both the awards this year and representing Council at local schools.
